Application Tools

The A+ suite of application tools allows users to have complete control over all aspects of the application process, including:

My Applications – A one-stop control panel where job seekers can save lists of the companies applied to, make notes about each employer, and even assign employers a private rating for easy reference in case of multiple job offers. Job seekers can also add any employer to their page, whether or not the employer is listed in the A+ database.

Saved Employers – With approximately 1,000 employers to choose from, this feature allows job seekers to “save” preferred employers to a personal page for later reference.

Resume Tools – From all aspects of a successful resume to customized cover letters, creating a resume is easy with A+. Resumes may also be formatted for printing with one click.

Update Contact Info – To keep up with the rapidly changing addresses of most students and resent graduates, the feature allows easy access to address changes that are immediately applied to all outstanding resumes and cover letters.
